the Big IDEA 🖫

Identify:

Identify a <u>small</u> section of a piece that needs work. This should be 1 to 12 measures, avoid large sections. Avoid "playing through" a whole piece.

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Decide:

Decide on an <u>OMG</u> = <u>Obtainable Musical Goal</u>
What aspect of music needs work?
Fingerings, Intonation, Rhythm, Tempo, Tone, Bowing,
Articulation, Dynamics, Phrasing...

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Execute:

Execute your goal using a variety of practice strategies.

Repetition will <u>always</u> be a part of working on a small goal, but should <u>not</u> be the only factor. Remember to take things slowly.



Analyze:

Analyze how you did. Did you improve? Did you reach your goal? Did you execute effective strategies? Should you try something else? What skills will it take to <u>obtain & maintain</u> mastery of your OMG?
